UCBC finished the tournament on Sunday in 14th place. Steve Connelley presented a check to UCBC for \$1,583.00. This was the money left over from the fundraiser after expenses from the State Tournament.

• Supplement to the METRO Report: By Thursday, October 3rd, because of the Government Shut-Down, Brenda Mareth and the Officers of METRO, cancelled the City tournament for Oct.5th and 6th.....and re-scheduled it for November 9th and 10th, to be held at the same venue (Amistad).
